

2009 H1N1 INTRANASAL VACCINE CLINIC

H1N1 Vaccine Eligibility:

Any individual ages 2 to 49, whose primary care physician or pediatrician CANNOT provide the vaccine; your local health department will vaccinate with a prescription from your physician.

Who Should NOT Get the Intranasal Vaccine?

- People with allergy to eggs
- Pregnant women
- Children 5 years of age with asthma or one or more episodes of wheezing during the past year
- Children or adolescents on long term Aspirin therapy
- Anyone with a weakened immune system due to HIV/AIDS
- Anyone in close contact with a person with a SEVERELY weakened immune system such as bone marrow transplant
- Anyone with chronic medical conditions; such as diabetes, heart, lung, kidney or liver disease, anemia and other blood disorders

****Children under 10 years of age MUST receive 2 DOSES at 3-week intervals****
