On or About Tuesday, October 11th, we will begin the 2022 Road Improvement Program for The City of Englewood. The scope of this project is to mill and pave several streets, as outlined below.

During construction, the road will be closed to thru traffic and no parking will be permitted on either side of the street during working hours (Monday Through Friday, 7:00 AM to 4:00 PM). Driveway access may be limited at times during milling operations. However, during paving operations, there will be no vehicular access on the street for several hours. All roadways will re-open in the evening. Specific questions or concerns can be answered by the Foreman in the field.

The following is an anticipated schedule, in the order listed below, which is weather-permitting:

- Tue 10/11 Milling Vermilye Street
Milling Hudson Ave. (Knickerbocker Rd to Tenafly Rd)
Milling Highland Ave.
- Wed 10/12 Milling Park Avenue
Milling Englewood Ave. (Lafayette Ave to Metzler's Bridge)
Milling Palisade Place
- Thu 10/13 Paving Park Avenue
Paving Englewood Ave. (Lafayette Ave to Metzler's Bridge)
Paving Palisade Place
- Fri 10/14 Paving Hudson Ave. (Knickerbocker Rd to Tenafly Rd)
- Vermilye Street and Highland Avenue will be paved once the concrete work has been completed. We will keep you posted.

We apologize for any inconveniences that this work may cause and we will work in a manner to try to complete this work as soon as possible.
