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Route 4 lane closures required in both directions this week as bridge project advances in Englewood Lane closures on Van Nostrand Avenue beginning Wednesday

(Trenton) – Route 4 is scheduled to have overnight lane closures in both directions this week as the Jones Road Bridge Replacement Project advances in Englewood, Bergen County. In addition, daytime lane closures are scheduled on Van Nostrand Avenue westbound this week.

Monday, April 15 Overnight Lane Closures

Beginning at 11 p.m. tonight, Monday, April 15, until 4:30 a.m. Tuesday, April 16, the right and center lanes on Route 4 eastbound are scheduled to be closed at the Jones Road overpass for the installation of steel beams. At least one lane will be maintained on Route 4 eastbound overnight. Motorists are advised to slow down, use caution, and expect delays.

Tuesday, April 16 Overnight Lane Closures

Beginning at 11 p.m., Tuesday, April 16, until 6 a.m. Wednesday, April 17, the right lane on Route 4 westbound is scheduled to be closed for the installation of bridge girders on the Jones Road Bridge over Route 4. At least one lane will be maintained during construction. Motorists are advised to slow down, use caution, and expect delays.

Wednesday, April 17 and Thursday, April 18 Daytime Lane Closures

From 7 a.m. until 3 p.m., Wednesday, April 17 and again on Thursday, April 18 at the same time, the right lane on Van Nostrand Avenue westbound is scheduled to be closed at the Van Nostrand-Grand Avenue Intersection to install traffic signal foundations. At least two lanes will be maintained during construction.

Wednesday, April 17 and Thursday, April 18 Overnight Lane Closures

Beginning at 11 p.m., Wednesday, April 17, until 7 a.m. Thursday, April 18 and again on Thursday night at the same time, the left lanes on Route 4 eastbound and westbound are scheduled to be closed for the installation of overhang platform on the Jones Road Bridge. At least two lanes will be maintained on Route 4 eastbound, and at least one lane will be maintained on Route 4 westbound during construction. Motorists are advised to slow down, use caution, and expect delays.

Friday, April 19 Daytime Lane Closures

From 7 a.m. until 3 p.m., Friday, April 19, the left lane on Van Nostrand Avenue westbound is scheduled to be closed at the Van Nostrand-Grand Avenue Intersection to install traffic signal foundations. At least two lanes will be maintained during construction.

Friday, April 19 Overnight Lane Closures

Beginning at 11 p.m., Friday, April 19, until 7 a.m. Saturday, April 20, the right lane on Route 4 westbound is scheduled to be closed to continue installing overhang platform on the Jones Road Bridge. At least one lane will be maintained during construction. Motorists are advised to slow down, use caution, and expect delays.

The \$20.7 million federally funded project will replace the Jones Road Bridge over Route 4 in Englewood, Bergen County. The new bridge will be approximately three feet higher to improve under-clearance issues on Route 4. Work is expected to be completed in summer 2025.

The precise timing of the work is subject to change due to weather or other factors.
