**AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING CONTRACT SALARIES AND
BENEFITS FOR TEAMSTERS LOCAL 11 IBT: INSPECTORS,
FOR THE YEARS 2024, 2025, 2026 AND 2027**

WHEREAS, contract settlements have been reached with IBT Local 11, Teamsters: Inspectors that establish salary amounts and benefits; and

WHEREAS, it is deemed to be in the best interests of the City to approve the terms of the Memorandum of Agreement and contract settlements.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Englewood, County of Bergen, State of New Jersey, as follows:

Section 1. The annual salary ranges for the positions covered by the Local 11, Teamsters: Inspectors Memorandum of Agreement and contract shall be as set forth on Schedule A, attached hereto and made a part hereof, effective as of the years and dates indicated.

Section 3. Other terms and conditions shall be maintained as set forth in the respective collective bargaining agreement. The City Manager is hereby authorized to execute the collective bargaining agreement with IBT Local 11, Teamsters: Inspectors.

Section 4. This ordinance shall become effective upon final passage and publication as required by law.
