### **NEW CITY PARKING KIOSKS HAVE BEEN INSTALLED**

As of Monday, December 8, 2025, the City of Englewood and Englewood Police Department will transition to a new, more modern system for metered parking in our City.

- Over 700 old individual parking meters will be removed.
- New parking kiosks have been installed at various locations in our downtown and surrounding areas. Some still need to be relocated and will be soon.
- The new kiosks will allow for multiple ways to pay for parking:
  - o Park Mobile App
  - o Coins or credit card
  - o Text-to-Pay
- On street parking will be limited to three hours per zone, per day.
  - o This will prevent vehicles utilizing street parking for extended periods of time and will enhance parking availability and turnover.
- The Park Mobile app is used all over in thousands of municipalities.
  - o Users can create favorite zones or areas
  - o Payment and parking status will be very convenient to manage
- The new parking zones will be clearly marked and easy to understand.
- New signage has been installed and more are coming.
  - o The new signs will make it easier for residents and visitors to navigate the City and our parking areas.
- Off-street parking in Municipal lots will also transition to the same system to better accommodate employees of our downtown businesses,
  - o Off-street parking is not limited to three hours.
- Additionally, permit parking and applications will move to an online portal which will make the process more streamlined and easier to navigate. This is anticipated to start in early 2026.
